## Rationale

AJK Medical College is the first public sector medical institution in Pakistan which adopted integrated undergraduate medical curriculum, right from its inception. Integrated Medical Curriculum is based on philosophy of holistic patient care, integrated health care teams and active learning principals. Considering the changing context of healthcare training (in 2nd spiral of curriculum) from didactic teaching of a medical school to a clinical / bedside teaching on real patients, the current module has been developed. Diversity of our students and faculty is a challenge as well as an opportunity to learn from varying perspectives.

Foundation of Clinical Practice & Medical Ethics (FCPM-0201) Module would provide a road map to the clinical teaching within ethical domain; Evidence based practice; Essential skills of communication with people; imperatives of patient safety & Professionalism; Exit competencies of AJKMC graduates; and role of a doctor in community, nation and community of nations.

During FCPM Module, the students of AJKMC would be introduced to the Allied Teaching Hospitals of AJKMC; Clinical Faculty; and academic facilities in Allied teaching hospitals. Moreover, the introduction to Information and Communication Technology (ICT), information retrieval, processing & analysis; Clinical Research; History of medicine and role of muslim scholars in its evolution; professionalism and community interaction will be integral components of this module. The FCPM Module will also sensitize the students regarding the Islamic perspective of medical education & healthcare in the light of Qur'an and Sunnah.

## Outcomes of Module

Foundation module would provide a road map to students and faculty regarding 2<sup>nd</sup> spiral of integrated curriculum, its philosophy, implementation and evaluation. By the end of this module, students of class of 2014-19 should be fully conversant with the Academic calendar, teaching and learning strategies, role of ICT in medical education, assessment practices at AJKMC and desirable professional behavior.

## Themes

### 1. Clinical teaching

**At the end of the module students should be able to:**

- Apply knowledge of basic medical sciences in clinical practice.
- Justify the various learning strategies operational in clinical teaching at national and international levels.
- Perform medical interviewing and clinical examination of real patients in a clinical setting.
- Interpret relevant information from patients, laboratory data, and other sources for clinical management.
- Role of laboratory medicine in clinical practice.

### 2. Professionalism & Medical Ethics

**At the end of session, the students should be able to:**

- Define Professionalism
- Differentiate between Morals, Ethics & Law
- Discuss ethical principles & values that guide good medical practice.
- Discuss ethical dilemmas in medical practice through case studies.
- Enumerate and interpret the components of professionalism.
- Define and draw a concept map for patient- Physician relationship
- Demonstrate Professional behavior at Workplace.
- Enlist and interpret basic characteristic of physician
- Discuss elements of good conduct:
  - ~ Honesty, Sincerity, and Well-wishing
  - ~ Altruism and Humanitarianism
  - ~ Professional Development
  - ~ Respect for Human Dignity and Sanctity of Life
  - ~ Sense of Responsibility and Accountability
  - ~ Personal Grooming
- Enlist the exit competencies of AJKMC graduates.
- Justify the twelve roles of doctor in AJK & Pakistan.

### 3. Communication and Relationship with People

**At the end of this session the students will be able to:**

- Enlist importance of Effective Communication

- Demonstrate effective communication with Colleague, Patients and their Attendants.
- Demonstrate effective communication in special circumstances.
- Demonstrate Courtesy and Confidentiality in terms of:
  - *The dilemma of Confidentiality as a trust*
  - *Shunning misconception about ailment*
  - Types of consent and their applications in the light of principles of autonomy, beneficence, do no harm, human dignity,
  - appropriate disclosure of information and capacity for decision making.

#### **4. Safe clinical practice**

**At the end of session, the students should be able to:**

- Describe various medical errors/hazards leading to death & disability of patients and health care workers.
- Describe various methods to improve the health care system to avoid medical errors.
- Identify the significance of open acknowledgement of medical errors and learning from mistake for improving safe medical practice.
- Define and interpret the basic elements of EBM/EBP.
